Rules

- -Have your child select a reasonable reading goal.
- -Start soliciting sponsorships using the Sponsorship Form on Friday, September 27.
- -Turn in all money collected and your Sponsorship Form on Friday, October 11.
- -Start recording your child's reading minutes on Saturday, October 12 using the Reading Log. Continue logging until Sunday, October 21.
- -The **Reading Log** must be used to keep track of minutes outside of school, and you must initial the log to ensure fairness and accuracy.
- -Do not guess minutes. Please use a clock or stop watch to log reading time.
- -Turn in your Reading Log by Monday, October 28.

Minutes That Count

- -Reading before and after school counts.
- -Reading before the official start of the *Read-a-Thon* does not count.
- -Reading during class does not count.
- -Being read to by other people counts as long as it is not during school hours.
- -Reading aloud to a pet counts.
- -Reading aloud to other people counts. If you are reading to someone who is also participating in the *Read-a-Thon*, it counts for both of you!
- -Homework reading (i.e. 100 Book Challenge) counts as long as it is done before or after school.
- -Reading on the bus or in the car counts.
